**Mrs. Rayleen Hendrix**, Apple Valley

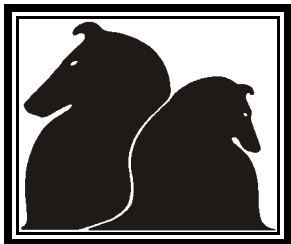

When my collie won that first ribbon, I was hooked. The dog that people most often remember of mine was Am/Can ch Apple Valley The Wagon Master, HC,TT. "Luke" was a big tri-colored dog who moved beautifully. He stayed in the Top 10 for a couple of years in the mid 80's. His pedigree was Hanover, Wickmere, and Bandor and his descendants comprise the current Apple Valley kennel.

## EXCERPTS FROM THE CKC DOG SHOW RULES

### ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS – Appendix B Premium Lists

Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you.

### EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER [ERN]

Effective 1 January 1992, all dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will no longer require a CKC registration number, but will require an Event Registration Number (ERN). The ERN must be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. The new fee is \$57.75 CDN per dog. For further information contact: The Canadian Kennel Club – Tel: 416-675-5511, Fax: 416-298-9671. Hours 9:00 AM (EDT) to 5:00 PM (EDT).

## JUDGES – Conformation Show Rules and Regulations, Chapter 19.7

It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under CKC rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

## CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS & CANCELLATIONS – Chapter 15

A dog awarded Winners at a conformation show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder.

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Dogs competing	1	2	3-5	6-9	10-12	13 +
Points allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

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In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall be included in the calculation for championship points. Points allocated includes the dog awarded Winners.

A dog may not be credited with more than 5 championship points in a single show.

In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion, the dog must:

- earn at least 10 championship points under at least 3 different judges at not less than 3 different shows;
- be registered in the records of the CKC or have an ERN;
- have earned at least one 2 point win either at the breed or group level.

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THE EXHIBITOR IS RESPONSIBLE FOR KNOWING AND COMPLYING WITH THE DOG SHOW RULES OF THE CANADIAN KENNEL CLUB.

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## GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Your Judging Schedule and Exhibitor ID will be emailed to you after entries close. Please include your email address on your entry form. If you do not show an email address, your Schedule and ID will be sent via Canada Post.
2. The building will be open Friday from 7 AM for set-up. The building will open Sat. and Sun. morning at approx. 7 AM [EDT]. Starting time will be specified in the Judging Schedule.
3. Dogs need only arrive 15 minutes before the scheduled judging time, and may leave the show when not required for further judging.
4. If a dog is not at ringside after it has been called three times by the Ring Steward, it will be marked absent. Please report all absentees to the Ring Steward.
5. If, because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the all breed club [ADKC] or the building management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.
6. The CCSSA will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability, in the event of accident or other misfortunes, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
